Give a gift to our mailman to say thank you for delivering our mail everyday.

Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. - Philippians 2:4

Take gifts to our neighbors and spend time catching up with each one.

This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. - John 15:12

Tape candy canes to ATM machines and at gas station terminals around town.

Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God. – Hebrews 13:16

Tape quarters to vending / toy machines around town.

You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people's feet. "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven. - Matthew 5:13

Take a bowl of candy to co-workers.

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.- John 3:16

Pay past due library fees for someone else.

Donate a poinsettia to the girl's school.

Pick out and take treats to students at school.

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness. - Galatians 5:22

Pick out and give a gift to teachers at school.

Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. - 2 Corinthians 9:7

Donate books and magazines to a school library and our local library.

"And may the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, as we do for you. - 1 Thess 3:12

Ring the Salvation Army bells and give extra money / Bring the Salvation Army worker a hot chocolate.

But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need, yet closes his heart against him, how does God's love abide in him? - 1 John 3:17

Get a street ready for Christmas by picking up trash alongside the road.

The one who exhorts, in his exhortation; the one who contributes, in generosity; the one who leads, with zeal; the one who does acts of mercy, with cheerfulness. - Romans 12:8

Pass out candy and spread cheer to people at the mall or local stores as they are shopping.

Help busy shoppers by taking back their shopping carts and holding open doors while wearing a smile to spread cheer.

Giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. - Ephesians 5:20

Visit and donate items to a local animal shelter.

Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? - Matthew 6:26

Buy coffee for a stranger at the local coffee shop.

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. - 1 John 4:7

Leave a basket of Christmas gifts on the doorstep of a family that needs it.

And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. - Colossians 3:17

Bring pictures drawn by the kids, flowers, sing and spend time with people in the nursing home.

Religion that is pure and undefiled before God, the Father, is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world. - James 1:27

Christmas Eve - Take a store employee a Christmas surprise.

This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. - John 15:12

Christmas Day - Deliver something special to the staff / patients at our local hospital

Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good. (10) Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor. - Romans 12:9-10

Take Christmas goodies to the local fire station.

Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you. - Ephesians 4:32

Give out presents at a local park.

Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth. - 1 John 3:18

Hide dollars in the toy section at Dollar Tree.

With all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love. - Ephesians 4:2

Leave a gift for the waiter/waitress at the restaurant.

Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone. - 1 Corinthians 12:4-6

Hand out free product coupons (slushy at Sonic, Frosty at Wendy's, etc...)
